

Resolution Of The Boone County Fiscal Court

Resolution No. 11-30

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE ENACTMENT OF H.R. 10, ALSO KNOWN AS THE "REGULATIONS FROM EXECUTIVE IN NEED OF SCRUTINY ACT OF 2011" (R.E.I.N.S. ACT OF 2011).

WHEREAS, regulatory reform legislation known as the REINS Act has been introduced by members of both the United States House of Representatives and United States Senate; and

WHEREAS, this regulatory reform legislation aims to increase the accountability and transparency with respect to federal agency rule making; and

WHEREAS, this proposed legislation would provide for congressional review and oversight of rule making by the executive branch before new regulations would take affect; and

WHEREAS, this improved accountability and transparency would provide more information and analysis regarding the impacts of executive branch rule making including the cost to taxpayers and consumers, the cost and affect of unfunded mandates upon state and local governments and any adverse impact on private business and industry; and

WHEREAS, this legislation will also insure that Federal agency rule making for all "major rules" will not be made by an appointed bureaucracy but rather elected officials through a more transparent lawmaking process.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Boone County Fiscal Court, hereby expresses support for the enactment of the R.E.I.N.S. Act of 2011 and encourages our Federal and State elected officials to support this legislation as well.
