RESOLUTION NO. 11-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE KENTON COUNTY FISCAL COURT EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR H.R. 10, THE REGULATIONS FROM THE EXECUTIVE IN NEED OF SCRUTINY (REINS) ACT INTRODUCED IN THE 112<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESS BY REPRESENTATIVE GEOFF DAVIS.

WHEREAS, Congressman Geoff Davis has introduced the Regulations from the Executive In Need of Scrutiny (REINS) Act in the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress with eighty-seven original sponsors; and

WHEREAS, the REINS Act would require that Congress take an up-or-down vote on every new rule with an economic effect of at least \$100 million before it could be enforced on the American people and businesses; and


WHEREAS, Kenton County Fiscal Court is concerned about the effect of burdensome Federal government rules, regulations, and unfunded mandates on citizens and businesses and supports legislation that will curb these effects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Kenton County Fiscal Court expresses support for H.R. 10, the Regulations from the Executive In Need of Scrutiny (REINS) Act introduced in the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress by Representative Geoff Davis.
