Our Internship Program

Collegiate and Graduate students are encouraged to apply for our unpaid internships located in Washington, D.C. and in the district offices in Bloomington and Jeffersonville. Our ideal candidate will have strong ties to the Ninth District of Indiana or the State of Indiana, but anyone is welcome to apply.

Our internship program gives students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in a Congressional office as well as the opportunity to work with Congressman Todd Young and his staff.

In Washington, interns' responsibilities will vary. They will be asked to answer phones, run errands, research legislation for the Member and legislative staff, attend hearings and briefings and answer constituent letters on various issues before the House. As a result, interns learn about the legislative process and the many other functions of a congressional office.

In the Indiana offices, interns may be asked to do a variety of things, including day-to-day office work such as answering phones, writing letters and assisting with media clips. In addition, interns may be assigned to assist in various constituent case work or work on District-based projects of importance.

Internships are available for the spring, summer and fall semesters. Spring internships run from January to May; summer internships run from May to August; fall internships run from September to December. Internships located in the district offices require at least 10 hours per week while internships in Washington, D.C. are both part- and full-time.
